<b>10.</b>	<b>Main objective/s</b>	The overall objective of the project is both to create an integrated value chain for improvement on the labour market and to facilitate access to the tertiary education system by developing educational services and the capacity of human resources through a series of specific activities, for 500 members of the target group, such as: organizing trainings and workshops on relevant themes, offering vocational and career counselling services,

providing assistance in a mobility programs and developing institutional cooperation establishing 40 cross-border partnerships between educational institutions and economic entities from the Ialoveni Region of the Republic of Moldova and four counties from Romania (Iasi, Botosani, Galati, Vaslui), for a period of 18 months.

The overall objective of the project contributes to the general objective of the Romania-Republic of Moldova 2014-2020 JOP, consisting in quality-of-life improvement for the people in the Programme area, through the following specific measures: stimulating participation in workplace learning programmes for students who are enrolled in upper secondary education, increasing specific and transversal skills and competencies, improving the labour market accessibility and, therefore, increasing the number of students that will find a job. These measures will actively and jointly contribute to the economic and social sustainable development of the regions on both sides of the common border.

1. Providing support programs for the development of transversal and practical skills as follows: organizing entrepreneurial and other soft skills online courses, providing counselling and guidance services (counselling for parents regarding the importance of tertiary education and vocational and career counselling for students), organizing relevant workshops and organizing a mobility program in Iasi, for 250 upper secondary education students, 100 tertiary education students from four counties of Romania: Iasi, Botosani, Galati, Vaslui, 80 parents/tutors of students and 30 upper secondary education teachers.

2. Developing cross-border partnerships to support the educational process through organizing and developing an Employers Days event and a workshop for employers with participation of the target group and relevant employers / actors from the cross-border region on the labour market, for 40 legal representatives of business sector organizations for the target group.

3. Enhancing institutional cooperation by establishing and signing 40 partnerships between educational institutions and economic agents on both sides of the border in order to increase the quality of higher

		education and help graduates develop relevant skills for facilitating access to the labour market.
